Paul McKenna from the Sunrise Club visited to thank us for our support of his son's Eagle

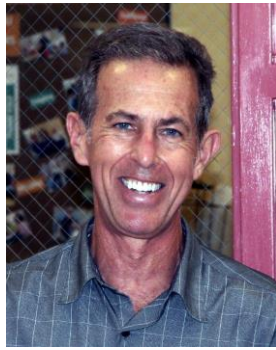


Scout project and to inform us of a local film festival.

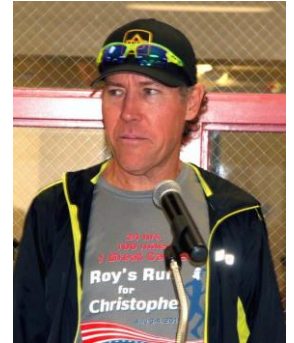
## Kiwanis Honors

Questions on the size of the Burbank Police Department standing force were addressed by our own member Lt. Eric Deroian. The department currently has 148 officers out of the 160 needed. Plans are in place to bring the staffing up to full force. Burbank is already

better staffed than most police departments. The city has been fully supportive in getting the department fully staffed.

The Burbank Blvd. off-ramp will be closed in 8 months. There will be 18 months of disruption.
