Committee Reports

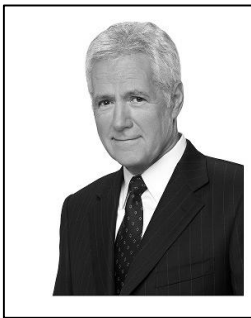

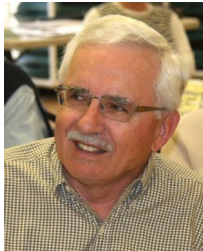

Dan Feger discussed the repositioning of the terminal for the Bob Hope Airport. Interesting facts were that we receive tax benefits of over \$12,000,000 a year which supplies the city with 70 police, salary and

benefits for firefighters, and the amount is double the library funds. Burbank also receives \$9,000,000 in property tax. In 1977 a joint powers agreement was established with Glendale, Pasadena, and Burbank cities. 5 votes are needed out of the 9 commissioners for something to pass.
